SUBJECT: HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUM RATE CHANGE

The monthly health insurance premium rates for state employees will change for the 2019-2021 biennium. Please note that employers who participate in the Wellness Program will be assessed the A rate and those who do not participate in the Wellness Program will be assessed the B rate. The new rates will be effective July 1, 2019 as follows:

The above premiums remain in effect through June 30, 2021.

Also, for members that participate in the High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP), the following is the amount that the state will contribute monthly towards the member's Health Savings Account (HSA) for eligible months of participation during the biennium:

Single Coverage:	\$88.34
